### Girl Rewards Guide



#### Donation option: Aquarium of the Pacific

Donate to the Aquarium of the Pacific to tend to their animals: The Aquarium of the Pacific displays more than 12,000 animals in 100 vibrant exhibits that celebrate the planet's largest and most diverse body of water, the

Pacific Ocean. Our goal is to instill stewardship for healthy ocean ecosystems and the inhabitants that live beyond our halls, like whales and dolphins. Your support allows us to continue providing the best possible animal care and medical treatment available, while funding our conservation initiatives and programs, and important breeding efforts so that you can ensure a better world for your favorite animals. Here are some examples of where the money could go:

- 130+ packages provides lunch for a tank of Moon Jellies that feed on brine shrimp grown at the aquarium. Visitors can watch as the Moon Jellies use their fine sweeping tentacles to gather the pink shrimp into their translucent bell.
- 500+ packages will help fund a feed in the Honda Blue Cavern exhibit that represents the underwater habitat you would find along our coast and around local islands such as Santa Catalina.
- 800+ packages- will feed a family of lorikeets for a day. The colorful birds drink nectar from small cups using their absorbent tongues.
- 1200+ packages will provide restaurant quality seafood, including capelin and herring, to feed a Magellanic Penguin for lunch. Our penguins eat their fish whole; some like to take it directly from their keepers, others like to put it on the ground to reposition it themselves.
- 1500+ packages supports a classroom of students to come to the aquarium on a field trip to learn about the Pacific Ocean, its inhabitants, and its ecosystem.
- 2000+ packages will feed sea dragons who eat live mysid shrimp from Florida, which are considered a specialty food item for these beautiful species.
- 3000+ packages will provide 15 pounds of fresh seafood for a sea otter. Otters need to eat about 25-30% of their body weight per day since they don't have blubber to keep them warm like other marine mammals.

Program Credits - Program Credit can be used in the Girl Scout Shop; for Membership Registration (for the girl only); to register for a Girl Scout Day, Resident or Specialty Camp; for other Council Program Events or Trainings (e.g., Gold Award Workshop), or, for girls who are aged 11 and older, toward a Destinations trip.

**Troop Money** - Girls who reach the 500+, 1200+, 1500+, 2000+, and 3000+ reward levels may choose to forgo the Reward item/Event or Program Credit and instead give the value of the Program Credit to their troop. This choice can be made for each of the stated package levels the girl reaches. The giving of troop money is for the *troop* to use toward activities that the girl will attend. These funds are not earmarked for the girl; they become troop funds that the girl can benefit from along with the rest of the troop.

Cookies for the Community - The Cookies for the Community (C4C) program is a council-wide community service project that gives Girl Scouts the opportunity to learn philanthropy and community service. Troops collect monetary donations from customers for cookies to be purchased by GSGLA, who coordinates delivery to our Cookies for the Community partners.

**Troop Proceeds:** When your troop participates in the Cookie Program, the troop earns proceeds on the girls' sales. These proceeds go into the troop's funds to benefit all girls in the troop. They can be used toward troop activities, such as troop meetings and supplies, trips, overnights; purchases for the troop from the Council Shop; or pay for girls' yearly membership. These funds are not earmarked for an individual girl; they become troop funds that the girl can benefit from along with the rest of the troop.

Higher Rewards – Note: For the events in 2024 reward line up, if it becomes necessary to cancel any event, the reward will either default to the item listed for Smart Cookie Club, Sweet Elite, and S'mores Adventure, or revert to Troop Money for the Cookie CEOs and Universal Studios Hollywood events.
